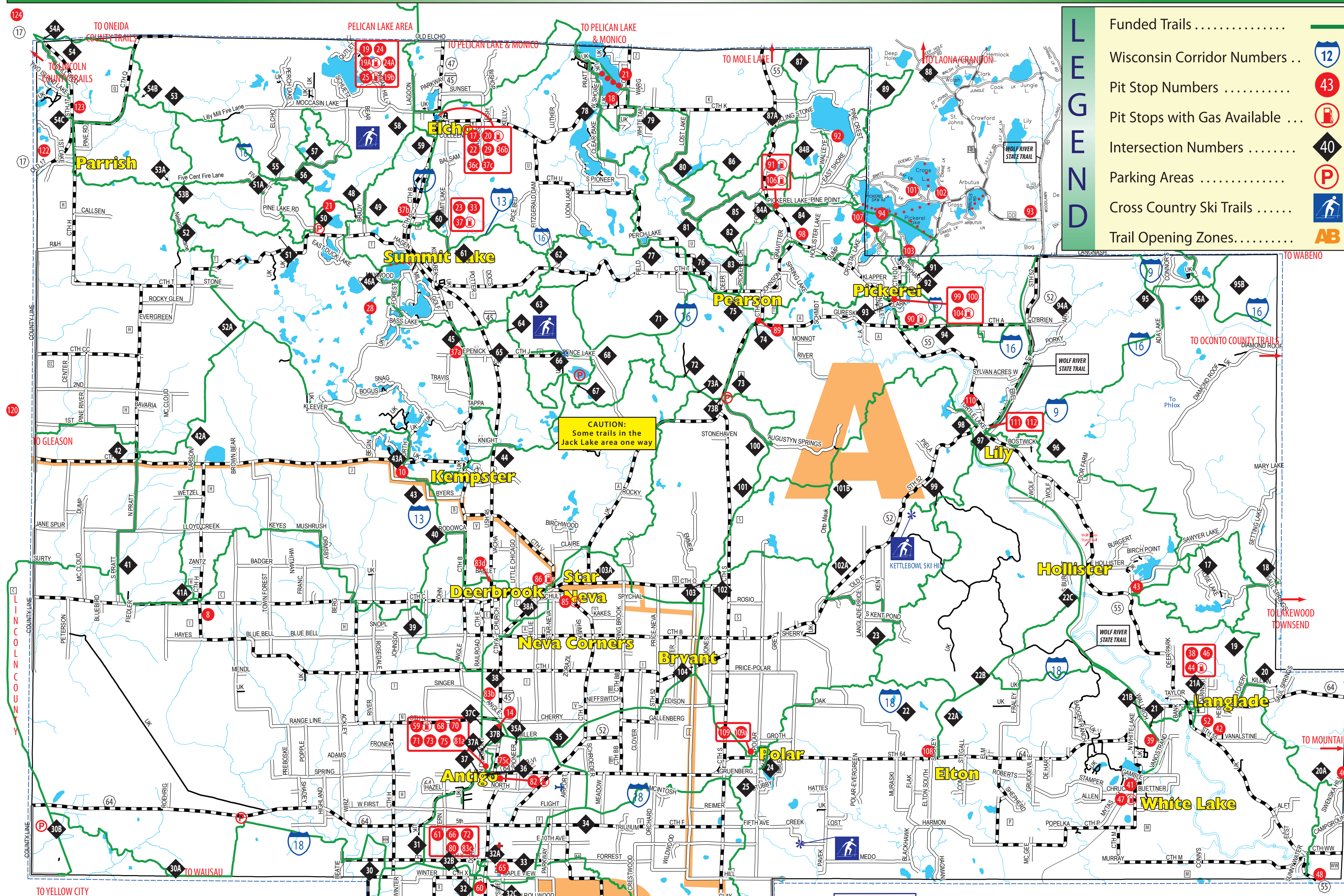

Notice - Stay on Trails \$200 Reward

For information leading to the arrest and conviction of anyone doing property damage on these trails, including destruction of signs, etc.

ATVs with the Wisconsin public registration are allowed on the Langede County Snowmobile Trail System 10 days after the trails are open in their respective zones, and the temperature is under 28°F. ATVs are not allowed in the Nicolet National Forest.

UTVs (SIDE BY SIDE) ARE NOT PERMITTED ON THE SNOWMOBILE TRAIL DURING THE WINTER

Trails in Langede County are developed and maintained by ten snowmobile clubs. These trails are state-approved and user-funded and total over 550 miles.

The Langede County Snowmobile Council, organized in 1974, is comprised of delegates from all area snowmobile clubs. The council, together with the Langede County Forest Administrator, coordinates the snowmobile and winter ATV programs in Langede County.

Please enjoy the trails, but use caution on the trails as some trail segments may be changed or rerouted. The Langede County Sheriff's Department operates a snowmobile patrol for your assistance.

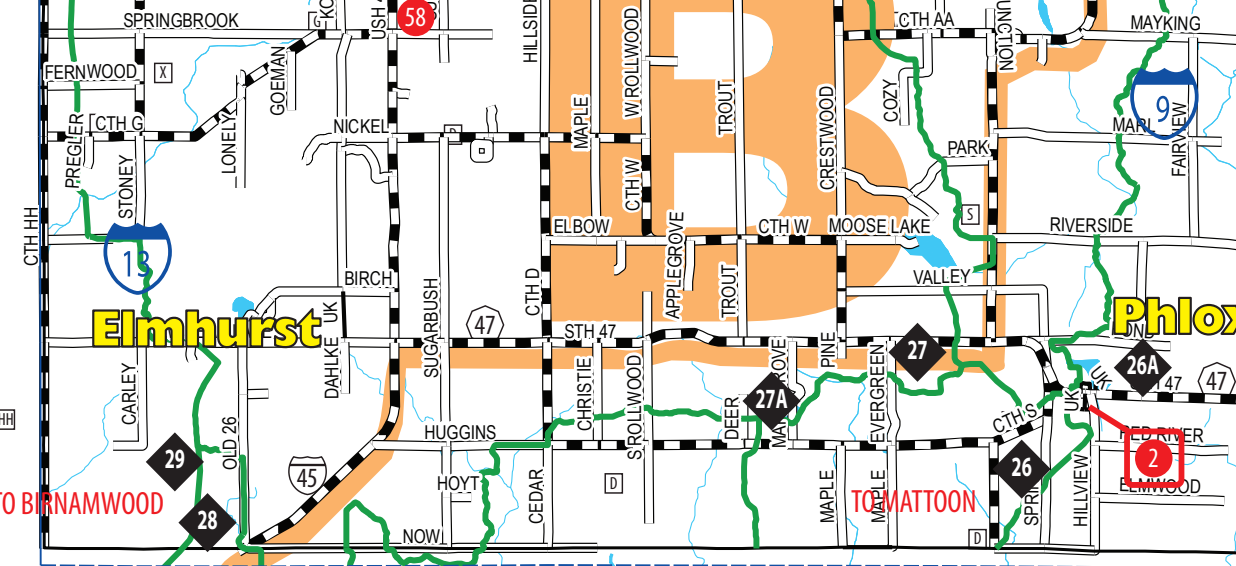
