

General Bow & Gun Range Safety Rules

1. Always point the muzzle in a safe direction.
2. Keep your finger off the trigger, and outside the trigger guard until ready to fire.
3. Keep the action open and firearm unloaded until ready to use.
4. All targets must be removed after shooting.
5. Firearms must be unloaded with actions open when anyone is down range.
6. Loaded guns are permitted only at designated firing points and must be pointed down range. No loaded firearms are permitted in the target areas or access trenches.
7. Do not pick up brass while shooting is in progress.
8. Pets must be under control of owners at all times.
9. Hearing and eye protection should be worn when on the firing line.
10. Designated trails must be used to change targets. (No one should be in the area in front of the firing line!) Shooters with disability permits are allowed to access targets via established access trails with ATVs.
