


# City of Antigo Parks and Trails



Our newest park area is the **Peaceful Valley Park and Event Center**. Springbrook Trail winds through this area and is paved for both pedestrian and bicycle use. Located between 6th & 7th Avenue along Field Street.

The **Optimist Skate Park** and **Mendlik Park Basketball Courts** will keep your heart pumping during the summer as you play some one-on-one or show-off your new moves.


Enjoy free outdoor summer concerts provided by the **Music in the Park** program (City Park West).

Stay warm this winter by working up a sweat and staying active through various winter park activities. Check out any of the **three outdoor ice rinks** (Third Ward, Peaceful Valley or Railway Activity Park), or just have some fun sledding down the **First Avenue Sled Hill** (located in the Railway Activity Park; 1011 First Avenue).

A portion of the Springbrook Trail is also groomed in the winter for **x-country skiing**. You may even wish to go exploring off the trail with your snowshoes.




Remington Lake

Your kids will love fishing the stocked pond at Remington Lake (stocked by the DNR, Antigo Sportsman Club, and Trout Unlimited).


The fishing pier was donated and built by: Antigo Chapter Trout Unlimited.
