Purchase: Obtain your annual pass at the Langlade County Forestry, Parks, and Recreation Department offices located at 1633 Neva Road, Antigo, WI 54409. This annual pass provides unlimited access to the range during normal operating times throughout the year, allowing you to make the most of the extended opening season. Take advantage of this cost-effective option and enjoy the convenience of having your pass ready whenever you wish to visit the range.
